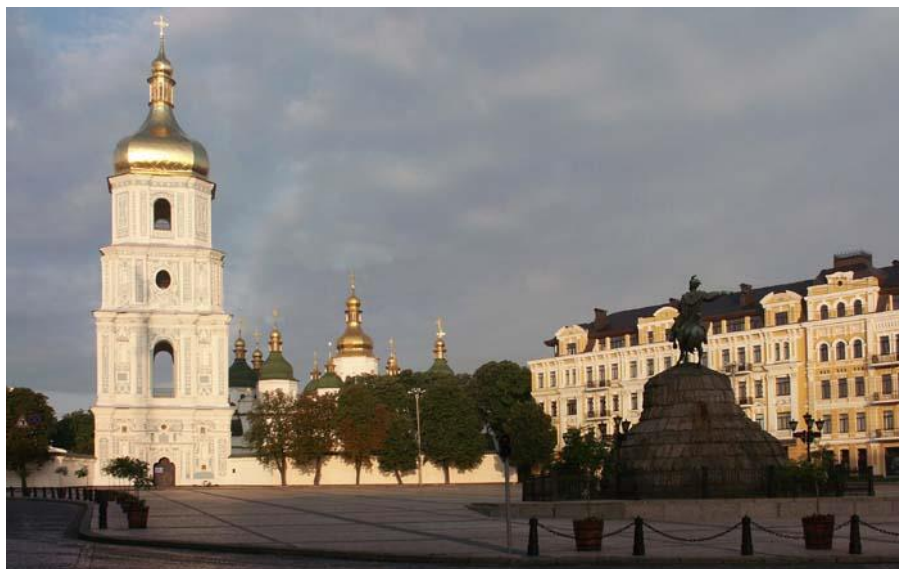


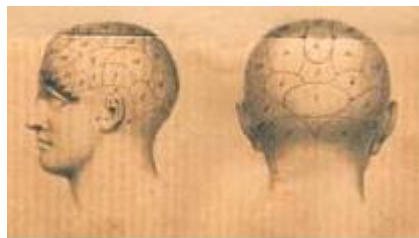

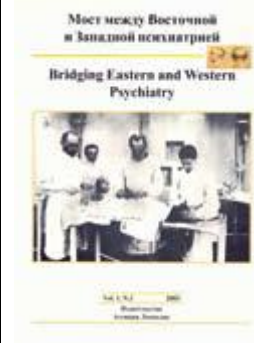

Dear Colleagues,

We are privileged to inform you that another conference dedicated to scientific and cultural exchange between Eastern and Western psychiatry is to be held in 2010 in Kyiv, Ukraine. The first conference of this series was held in 1998 in Lviv, Ukraine. It was organized by Mario Di Fiorino of Italy, Maria Luisa Figueira of Portugal, Professor Adam Szymusik of Poland, and Professor Alexander Filts, and Taras Dasho of Ukraine. The first four conferences on bridging Eastern and Western psychiatry were held in Lviv. We believe we have achieved our primary goal of establishing the collaboration between psychiatric communities of Eastern and Western Europe. Since the time of the first conferences, this collaboration has expanded considerably, attracting new supporters from other countries – Russia, Poland, Estonia, Slovenia, Turkey, Armenia, etc. We have also created a psychiatric journal.

The Association has held 11 conferences in different cities of Europe. In 2010, the 13<sup>th</sup> Conference is supposed to return to Ukraine. It will be dedicated to important current issues of clinical psychiatry, psychopharmacology, and psychotherapy of mental disorders. The more detailed information will be given in the next announcements. Considering the great interest of Ukrainian psychiatrists, and upon agreement with the Head Physician of Kyiv City Psychiatric Hospital, Professor Vyacheslav Mishiyev the Conference will be held in the hospital’s Assembly Hall.
