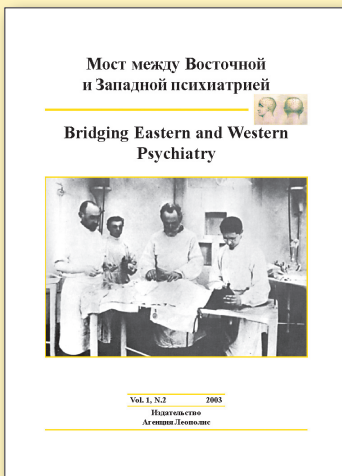

The Halls are provided with double Power point projection equipment. Please contact the technician at least 30 minutes before the beginning of the session.

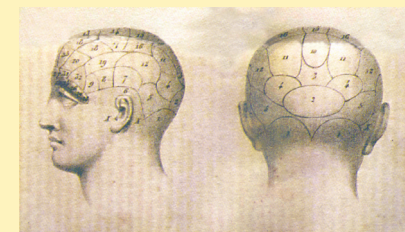

We are glad to invite you to Warsaw, the capital of Poland, a most important trade-financial and political centre of Poland. Although today's Warsaw is a fairly young city, it has many tourist attractions. Apart from the Warsaw Old Town quarter, carefully reconstructed after World War II, each borough has something to offer. Among the most notable landmarks of the Old Town are the Royal Castle, King Zygmunt's Column, Market Square, and the Barbican.

In Warsaw there are many places connected with the life and work of Fryderyk Chopin. The heart of Polish-born composer is sealed inside Warsaw's Holy Cross Church. Also many references to Marie Curie, her work and her family can be found in Warsaw: Marie's birthplace at the Warsaw New Town, the working places where she did her first scientific works and the Radium Institute at Wawelska Street for the research and the treatment of cancer which she founded in 1925.

The conference will focus on "Psychiatry in a changing world". We look forward to welcoming you in June 2014, and sharing with you our passion for both quality scientific researches and cultural exchange.
